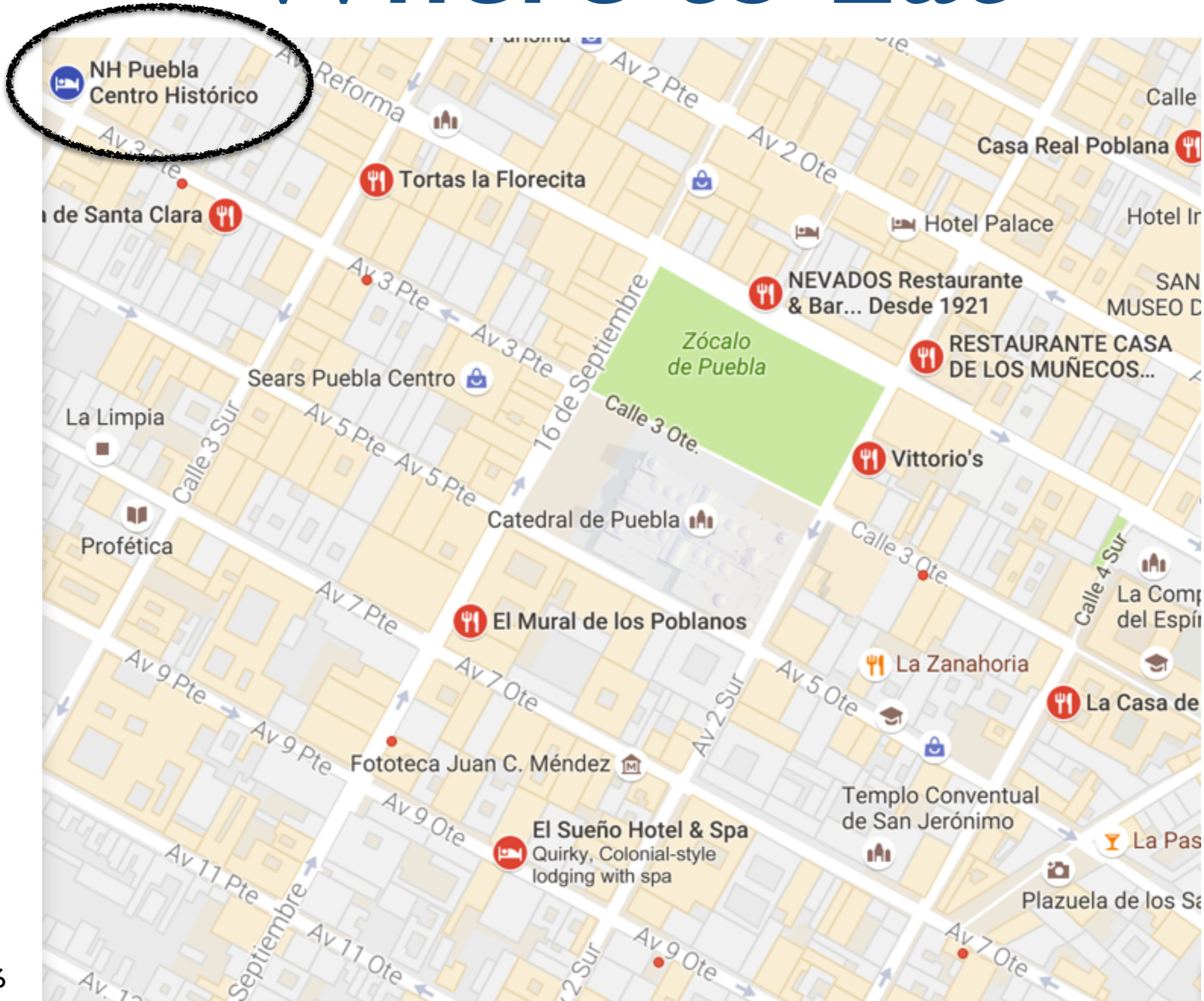

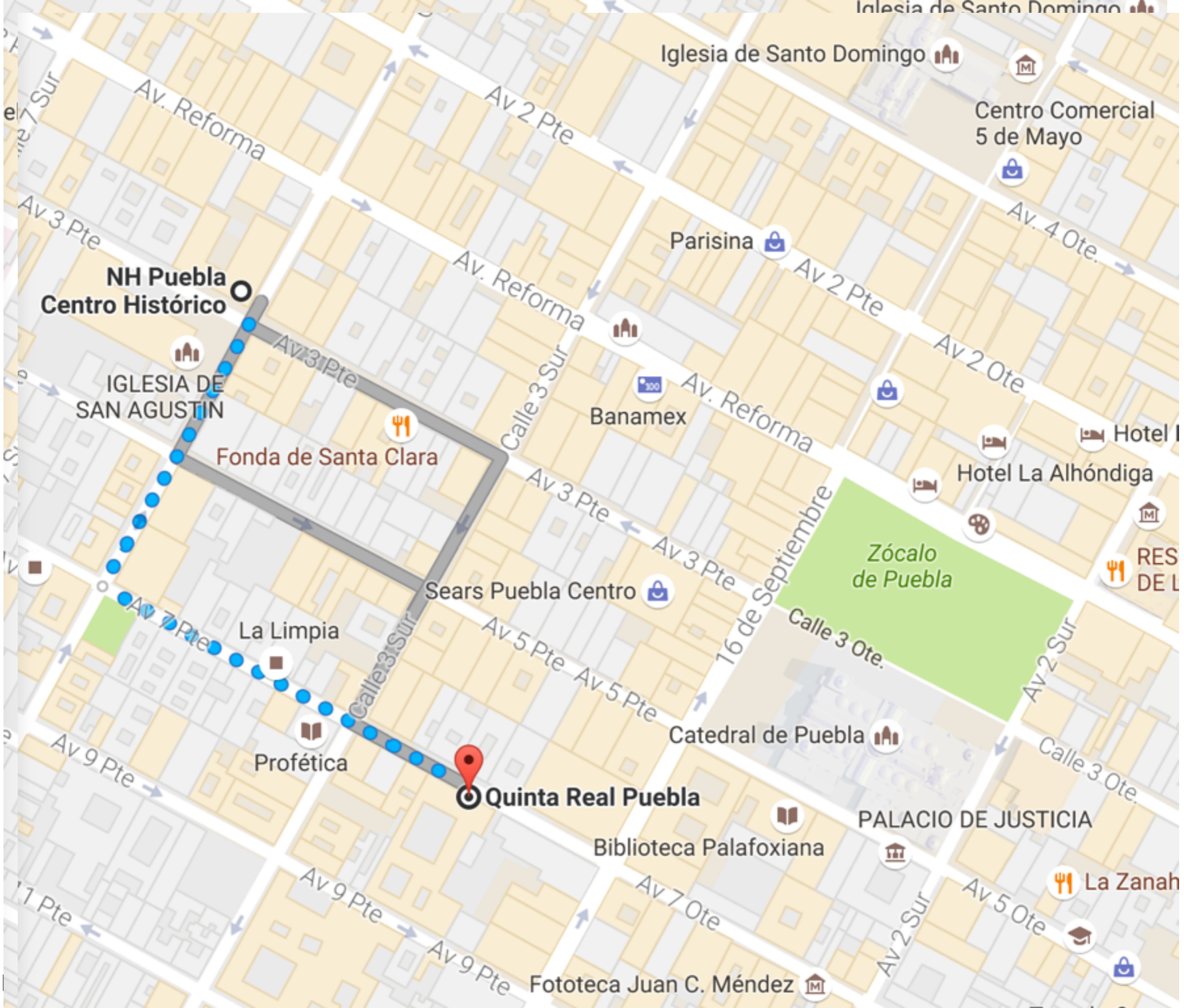

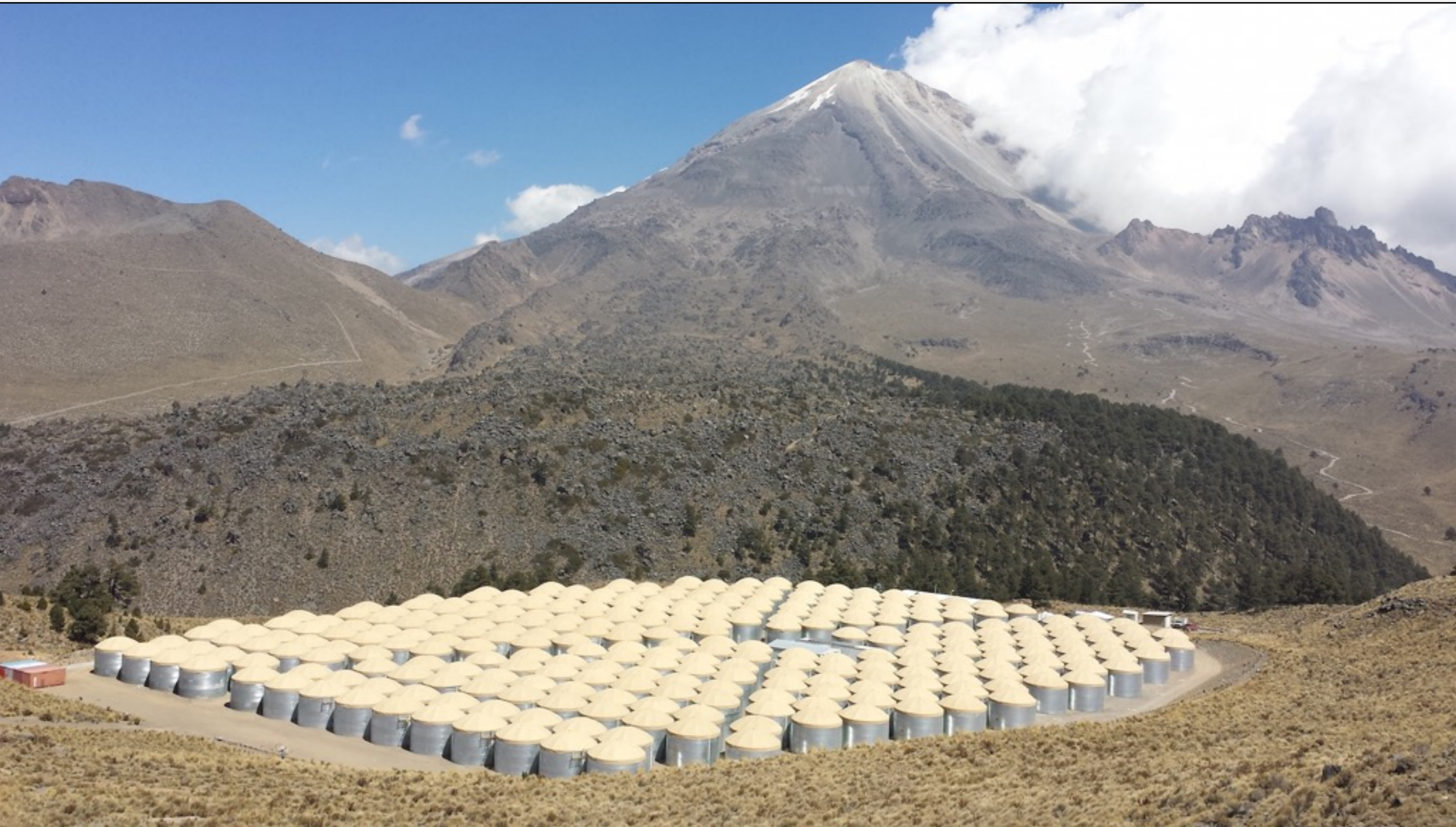

# Preparation for the Visit

- ▶ HAWC is 4100 m above sea level so be aware of these issues:
  - Significant **UV radiation**; use sunscreen and sun glasses
  - **Low temperature/high winds**: dress in layers
  - **Hypoxia**: headaches, numbness, fatigue, nausea, reasoning impairment. Make sure to stay hydrated at all times
  - **High-altitude pulmonary edema**: difficulty breathing while at rest, coughing, weakness, tightening of the chest
- ▶ Move slowly. Don't push yourself physically
- ▶ If you feel ill let your group leader know immediately and you will be driven to lower altitude. Oxygen is also available at the site in case of medical emergencies
